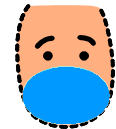

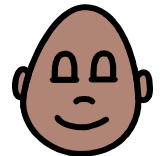

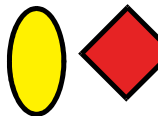


## Lets work together to stay safe

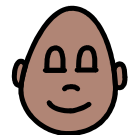
